SFX of 'rustling'.

SAM

Ah! Who's there?

SFX of 'rustling', maybe hard-panned to other side.

SAM

Tr-tr-trick or treat?

SFX of something rushing out.

WEREWOLF

Roar!!!

SAM

Ah, a werewolf!

WEREWOLF

Roar!!!

SAM

Want to hear my P-P-Paul M-M-Martin?

WEREWOLF

Roar!!!

SAM

You know, w-w-were-wolf comes from the Old English for m-m-man-wolf.

WEREWOLF

Roar!!!

SAM

Boy, is this 1-1-lycanthrope negligent of vocabulary or w-w-what?!

WEREWOLF
